Make sure potential buyers' first impression of your home is a good one, let's start with the outside..

Curb Appeal

- Close your garage doors
- Remove all cars from the driveway. Park them either in the garage or street
- Hide your garbage cans in the garage or somewhere they are not seen from the road
- Lawn freshly mowed, edged, and weeds pulled
- Leaves are picked up
- Pick up/put away any misplaced items such as toys, empty planters, water hoses and garden tools
- Mulch around flowerbeds and trees
- Shurbs are trimmed
- Paint the front door and or columns if needed
- Create an inviting front porch
- Add colorful plants
- Remove all trash at the curb unless it is garbage day

PHOTOSHOOT CHECKLIST

General

- Complete a thorough cleaning including vacuuming, mopping and dusting
- Organize any open storage areas & bookcases so they are neat, clean and decluttered.
- Turn ON all lights included under counter
- Replace any burned out or missing light bulbs. Ensure they are all the same color
- Shut off all televisions and computer screens
- Natural light is key. Pull back all window treatments & open blinds halfway throughout. Make sure they are even
- Wipe down all surfaces including appliances, baseboards & trim
- Turn OFF all ceiling fans
- Make the beds. Double check that items stored under the bed can't be seen and sheet are not hanging out from the comforter
- Eliminate excessive personal photos
- Remove all unnecessary items off dressers and electronic cords
- Store all shoes, jackets and book bags in the closet

Kitchen

- Clean/wipe down countertops & appliances
- Clear off countertops of all baking supplies, knife blocks, cutting boards, etc
- Remove all appliances on the countertop except one small one or a coffee maker
- Remove all magnets, papers and photos from the refrigerator
- Remove all items from the top of the refrigerator
- Conceal or remove the garbage can
- Turn on any speciality lighting
- Remove all sponges, rags and dish soap dispensers from the sink area. No dishes in the sink

Dining Rm

- Clear off your dining room table of items
- Remove the table cloth if under is in good condition
- Make sure all the chairs are evenly spaced and pushed in
- Set up a decorative centerpiece such as a vase of flowers

PHOTOSHOOT CHECKLIST

Bathrooms

- Completely clear off your countertops including soap dispensers, toothbrushes, & personal items
- Remove soap, shampoo and all items from showers with glass doors
- Remove floor mats
- Remove used bath towels, hand towels and wash cloths. Display only new or unused towels that match
- Toilet seats down
- Trash cans, toilet brushes and plungers removed
- Remove all towels and robes behind the door
- Remove items on the back of the toilet

Pets

- Remove all food, water bowls, pet toys and bedding
- Apply a lint roller to furniture and thoroughly eliminate pet hair
- Contain pets outside or in a crate
- Wash doors and glass to remove paw prints
- Make sure all litter boxes are clean, removed or hidden
- Clear the yard of pet waste, toys, beds, water bowls and leads

Yard

- Pick up/put away toys, athletic equipment and games
- Stage your patio or deck
- If you have a pool: Vacuum, skim, clean pool/surround area, remove chemicals, cleaning supplies and activate any water features/fountains
- Eliminate faded/stained cushion, pillows
- Open umbrella on table
- Clear the yard of pet waste, toys, beds, water bowls and leads
